What is PGPEX?

- Master's program, offered by the Indian Institute of Technology-Kanpur, Indian Institute of Technology-Madras and Indian Institute of Management-Calcutta, which aims to nurture future leaders in Indian manufacturing industries
- Requires prior work experience of at least four-years in a relevant industry upon application
- Organizes a two-week field trip in Japan

- Venues: Nagoya University Higashiyama Campus, JICA Chubu Center (Sasashima Live Station)
- Language: English

- Number of Participants: 20 from Nagoya University and Gifu University, 40 from PGPEX
