

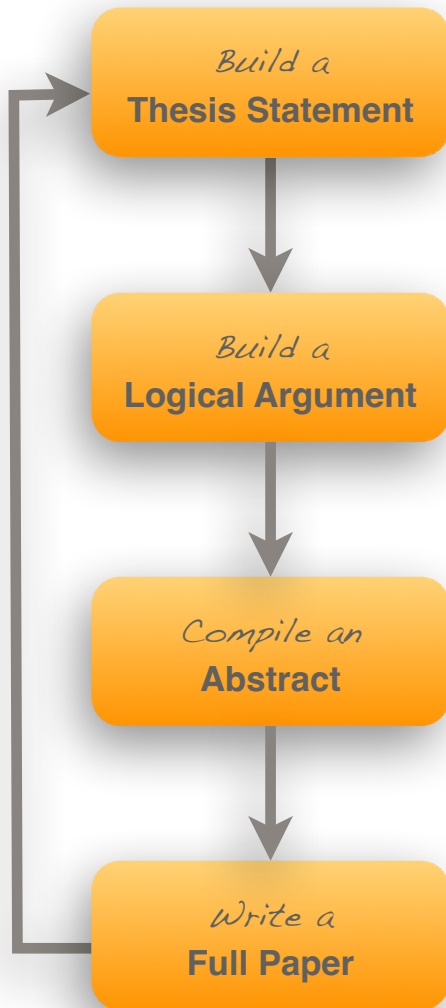

# Research Skills Courses 2025



### **Research Skills T: Logical Research Writing I (Eng)**

**Instructor: Paul Lai, Day/Period: Tuesday/3rd**

This course aims to help you publish your paper by helping you develop a clear research idea and a convincing argument for the idea.

### **Research Skills W: Fundamentals of Academic Writing (Eng)**

Learn basic research writing skills, analyze a paper published in your field, and write an abstract for your own paper.

### **Research Skills W: The Secrets of Research Writing (Eng)**

Learn the hidden tools of research writing to enable you to construct a new research project from scratch or upgrade your existing one.

### **Research Skills P: Practical Presentation Skills (Eng)**

Acquire important skills and confidence to make effective research presentations in a relaxed, supportive class atmosphere.

### **Research Skills P: Academic Presentation Design (Eng)**
